National Public Service Recognition Week

WHEREAS, public service was considered joining the military to provide security to your people; and,

WHEREAS, as city-states formed and grew, the concept of public service grew; and,

WHEREAS, the concept of public service is held high in every society, and in the U.S., the foundations of public service were laid during the compiling and signing of the Constitution of the United States of America; and,

WHEREAS, proper departmentalization of public service began in 1871 when President Ulysses Grant formed the first Federal Civil Service; and,

WHEREAS, in 1985, President Ronald Reagan introduced Public Service Recognition Week honoring the duty and moral obligation that public servants fulfill.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Travis Gibson and the City Council of Bellmead do hereby recognize the first week in May as National Public Service Recognition Week.
